Mailgate mail server and proxy server


Web Browser and other client programmes connect to the MailGate Server.



The mail programme on each computer sends outgoing mail to the MailGate Server and collects new mail from the users POP account.



The MailGate Server makes the connection, then browsing and other requests are passed to the Internet Service Provider.



The MailGate Server exchanges incoming and outgoing E-mail with the Internet Service Provider on scheduled connections.

Powerful mail server

The feature-rich MailGate mail server provides a comprehensive mail solution for your local area network and supports systems based on both SMTP and POP3 delivery from multiple accounts. It incorporates many automated features to improve productivity, control and costs.

- Sends mail from one local user to another without connecting to your ISP.
- Defines regular schedules for sending and collecting Internet mail without user intervention.
- Incorporates flexible setup to minimise call costs.
- Ensures outgoing and priority mail is actioned without delay.
- Powerful rules sort mail into user mailboxes.
- Allows multiple addresses for one mailbox.
- Automatically forwards a copy of incoming mail to other mail addresses.
- Deletes incoming mail after mail forwarded to users.
- Sends automatic reply to e-mail.
- Archives all outgoing e-mails.
- Easily used as a POP3 front end for other mail servers.

Pre-defined proxy gateway services

MailGate incorporates many pre-defined proxy gateway services, including sophisticated custom features allowing you to define your own proxies.

- Web proxy – for full Web browsing access.
- FTP proxy – for true FTP site access.
- SOCKS proxy – supports both versions 4 and 5.
- DNS relay – to proxy DNS user requests (required for some Java applets).
- Real audio-visual proxy
- NNTP proxy – for connecting to newsgroups.
- Telnet proxy – for connecting to other systems on the Internet.

Comprehensive security

MailGate's security features protect your users, your networks and your business data.

- Controls access to individual services by machine name or IP address.
- Enables password-protected Web browsing access.
- Supports multi-home systems for improved network security.
- Makes use of NT security when running under NT.
- Comprehensive logging facility assists in diagnosing problems.
- Binds MailGate services to specific IP addresses, blocking external access.
- Blocks mail relaying through the mail server.

Easy-to-use system administration

MailGate incorporates a simple-to-use administration interface with extensive logging options. It provides many valuable features to improve control and costs.

- Backup and restore registry settings.
- Load mailboxes from external files.
- System events and problems notified by e-mail.
- Administration messages sent to any local or remote e-mail address.
- Automatic termination of excessive duration connections.
- Limit and manage collection of large e-mails.
- Review screen for failed outgoing mail.
- Notification of oversize user mailboxes.

Optional modules

MailGate offers a range of optional modules to further extend the functionality, allowing other software products to be integrated to MailGate.

- Virus scanning module – scans all incoming mail.
- Extended mail handler – extends mail processing.
- Extended system administration – provides more useful administrative data.
- SpamMail filter – helps to block spam mail.
- List server – provides full list server capability.

System requirements

- IBM compatible 386 or higher with 16MB RAM running
 - Windows 95/98 or Windows NT3.51* or later.
- *To run under Windows NT3.51 you must have service pack 5 applied.

Mailgate requirements

- Connection to an Internet Service Provider. This can be a broadband or dial-up connection.
- TCP/IP installed on all machines in the network that use MailGate.
- Can use direct IP addresses or Domain Name Server (DNS) or LMHOSTS/HOSTS files for name resolution on the network.
- For a dial-up connection, dial-up networking installed on the machine running MailGate. This may be PSTN or ISDN.
- For ISDN on NT, 128k multi-channel operation supported.
